## OVERVIEW

SPB TV is a highly usable IP-TV solution, optimized to run on mobile devices. SPB TV provides users with lots of channels in multiple languages with easy-to-use features and settings. No subscription fee!

### Software Features

#### Video on Demand

Video on Demand channel lets the viewer control what they view and when they want to view. Unlike broadcast TV, VOD offers greater choice and interactivity.

#### Freeware

SPB TV 2.0 is free for the end-user and requires no subscription fee which makes it advertising-supported software. A full-screen image ad insertion will appear between data buffering times as in opening and switching quality times to deliver uninterrupted mobile TV experience.

#### On-Screen Control Panel

In the full-screen mode you can recall the on-screen control panel at any time by pressing the "action" button. The on-screen controls will give you quick access to the channel browsing panel, volume level controller, backlight level controller, and the exit button.

#### Integrated TV Guide

Under the preview picture you can see the integrated TV guide, pressing on it will open the full guide for the next few days of the selected channel.

#### Setting a Reminder

You can easily make Calendar reminder, from the TV guide, if you see an interesting show that you don't want to miss.

#### Battery Indicator

In the full screen watching mode you can see the battery level, estimated battery time and current time by pressing the "MENU" button or tapping the screen.

#### Picture-in-Picture

In the channel switching panel you can see a preview picture of a selected channel displayed in inset window while the main channel is on the full-screen at the same time.



## INSTALLATION

Installation of SPB TV is a very simple process and takes less than five minutes to complete. The following installation guide will help you.

### System Requirements

Make sure your system meets the following minimum requirements before installation.

Android 1.5 and higher



### Installing

To install SPB TV access Android Market™:

On the Home screen, touch the Application button.

Touch Market. When you first enter Android Market, you will see featured items, a list of item categories, a link to search, and a link to My downloads.

Search for "SPB TV" and download it.

If you scroll down in the Item details screen to the About the developer section, you can view more applications by SPB Software or send us an e-mail message.

## USING SPB TV

An Internet connection is required in order to use SPB TV service. Establish your preferred Internet connection method depending on your tariff plan before starting the program. Please note that data charges may apply for usage of SPB TV over phone's wireless network.

- At the first launch you will be asked to provide your email address, date of birth, and gender. The personal information we collect allows us develop, deliver, and improve our products, services, content, and advertising. Your information will not be sold, bartered, or shared with third parties without your permission.
- Select your favorite channels and organize them for quick access from Menu > Reorder Channels and uncheck channels that you do not want to watch. Tap-and-hold on a channel icon, then move it up or down to organize the channels list. Start the list order with the most important channels. You can also tap-and-hold on a channel name to quickly jump-move the channel to the very top or to the bottom of the list.
- In any of SPB TV screens, press the "MENU" button to view the available options.
- Touch the TV channel preview picture to start watching in full screen mode. Under the preview picture you can see the integrated TV guide (if available), open it to see the full guide for the next few days.
- In the TV guide screen, you can set a reminder by simply touching the appropriate show name to be added as Calendar event.
- When selecting a VOD channel you will be able to scroll the playlist content and choose the video that you would like to watch.
- In the full screen mode you can recall the on-screen control panel at any time by tapping the screen or pressing the "MENU" button. The on-screen controls will give you quick access to the battery indicator (on the top-right corner), channels browsing panel (PIP mode), volume level controller, backlight level controller, and the exit button.
- During buffering periods an advertisement screen will be shown. If you are interested in the advertized product, service, or website, touch it to view the ad screen available options.
- You can use the following hardware keys to navigate through SPB TV in the full screen watching mode:
  - Trackball up/down -> volume level up/down
  - Trackball left/right -> PIP (picture in picture) channel browser
  - Trackball "action" button -> display on-screen control panel



## Tips

- The Trackball "action" works as a mute button when the volume level control is displayed.
- If you have a slow Internet connection, you may need to switch to low quality video that will put less strain on network and memory resources, giving you a smoother and uninterrupted TV viewing.

## Note

The channels list may frequently change depending on the channel's source availability and stability. Each time a channel changes, a new index is generated and sent to the app automatically.
