## Overview

SPB Radio is a high-quality Internet radio player for Windows Phones, which gives subscription-free access to an unlimited number of live streaming radio stations from all over the world.

## Software Features

### Built-In Catalog

Adding a radio station is easy using SPB Radio online catalog. The catalog contain thouthands of radio stations from all over the world, orgnized by category, region, and language. Searching for a station is also supported.

### Custom Stations

You can easily add stations manually by providing the station URL. SPB Radio supports only MP3, WMA, and OGG streaming formats.

### User Friendly Interface

SPB Radio touch-oriented user interface provides you a quick and easy access to your favorite radio stations. The player controls can be operated just by fingers or keypad buttons without the need to use the stylus. SPB Radio interface also features:

- **Animated Transitions:** The animated transitions give you excellent visual cues to help you understand where you are, where you have come from, where you are going, and to keep you oriented.
- **Kinetic Scrolling (on touch screen):** The catalog list of SPB Radio can be scrolled with flicking gestures that feel like moving a wheel and more natural than the conventional approach of scroll bars.

### Screen Off

You can listen to your favorite stations while the screen is switched off to reduce the battery consumption while entertaining.





## Installation

Installation of SPB Radio is a very simple process and takes less than five minutes to complete. The following installation guide will help you.

### Installing

After you have downloaded the SPB Radio distribution file you should install it to your device. For a successful installation you will need a device attached to your Windows desktop PC. You will also need Microsoft ActiveSync software in order to install SPB Radio to your device.

When you run the software installer on your desktop PC it will ask you to accept the license agreement and will start the installation program. You will be prompted for the location where you want the software to be installed.

Another way is to download the SPB Radio.CAB distribution file on your desktop PC then move the .CAB file to your device. You can also download it directly using your device Internet browser. After you have downloaded and transferred the .CAB file to your device storage card, run the file to begin the installation process and follow the on-screen instructions.

### Registration

You will be able to use SPB Radio until the end of the trial version period of 15 days. If you have not registered SPB Radio within this timeframe, you will need to do so to continue using it.

To obtain the serial number you need to purchase SPB Radio software license and you will receive your serial number by email.

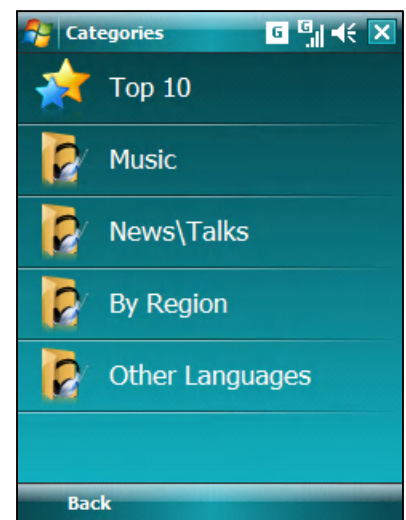


## Using of SPB Radio

An Internet connection is required in order to use SPB Radio service. Establish your preferred Internet connection method depending on your tariff plan before starting the program.

SPB Radio provides you with a real time streaming of radio stations from all over the world and delivers it to you in high quality and with a finger friendly interface.

- Start by adding your favorite stations to the list. Select **<Click to add stations>** or go to **Menu > Add Station** to open the online stations catalog.
- The stations catalog is well organized by categories. Select a category and then a station to be added to the favorite list.
- To add a station that is not included in the catalog database, go to **Menu > Add URL** and type in the station URL address and select **Done**. Only MP3 and WMA streaming formats are supported in SPB Radio.
- To remove a station, Tap-and-hold on a station to view the **Remove Station** option. On non-touchscreen devices, go to **Menu > Remove Station**.
- Enable **Use Free Only** option from the main menu if you would like to prevent unexpected high-cost downloads. SPB Radio will work only when your device is connected to the Internet via a free Internet connection such as WiFi.
- Enable **Use On Roaming Too** option from the main menu if you would like to use SPB Radio over GPRS, EDGE, or 3G connection when on Roaming.
- The radio control panel includes a play/pause button, station title, bitrate indicator, current status, and volume level controller.
- You can listen to your favorite stations while the screen is switched off by selecting the **Screen Off** softkey, to reduce the battery consumption while entertaining.
- To organize your favorite stations list, tap-and-hold on a station and view the available options. On non-touchscreen devices go to **Menu > Move Station**.
- Select **Exit** menu item to close the application.



### Important

The **Screen Off** functionality might be disabled on some devices to prevent hardware multi functioning.

### About The Trial Version

The trial version of SPB Radio includes all of the features available in the registered version. The trial version expires within 15 days after installation. You can use the trial version only to check how SPB Radio works. In order to keep using the software you need to purchase the license. There is no need to re-install the SPB Radio in order to use the full version.
